

The Redstone Arsenal Military and Civilians' Club (RSAMCC) will be awarding educational merit awards in 2021 to eligible students who are affiliated with and acting as contributing members of the Redstone Arsenal, Alabama, military and government civilian community. THE RSAMCC IS A 501(c) 4 PRIVATE ORGANIZATION NOT AFFILIATED WITH REDSTONE ARSENAL OR THE US ARMY. There were two scholarships to apply for this year. 1. RSAMCC Merit Award Application – For members of RSAMCC and their dependents 2. (NEW) RSAMCC Military Community Scholarship Application – The eligibility requirements are the same as the RSAMCC Merit Awards, with one exception. Applicants do NOT need to be a member of the RSAMCC Club to be eligible.

DEADLINE TO APPLY: February 28, 2021



SCHOLARSHIP * ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS



Merit Awards eligibility is open to the following:

- Graduating high school seniors of the Class of 2021 who plan to continue their education.
- Currently enrolled full-time college students, and military spouses enrolled in college (full- or part-time).
- Armed Forces personnel (Active/Reserve) or civil service employee assigned to, attached to, living on or residing in the vicinity of the Redstone Arsenal Community or the Greater Tennessee Valley area.
- Armed Forces personnel (Active/Reserve) or civil service employee currently serving an unaccompanied short tour from RSAMCC and returning to Redstone Arsenal.
- Retired military personnel residing in the Redstone Arsenal Community or the Greater Tennessee Valley area.
- Gold Star Family Members of deceased military personnel residing in the Redstone Arsenal or the Greater Tennessee Valley area. Applicant's home of record must be within a 50-mile radius of Redstone Arsenal.
- Applicant must not be in receipt of a full scholarship (pays tuition, room, board, books, lab fees, etc...) or full post-9/11 GI Bill.
- Applicant must NOT be a past recipient of a RSAMCC Merit Award.

All applicants are eligible for MOAA-sponsored scholarships.

Applicant's being sponsored by an RSAMCC member will have priority for club-sponsored scholarships.

Deadline to become an RSAMCC member is January 15, 2021.

If you do not meet these eligibility requirements, your application will NOT be considered. Additional proof may be required on a case by case basis. The applicant's sponsor (for spouses) or legal guardian (for children) must share the same home of record with the applicant and belong in one of the above categories.

RSAMCC Community Assistance Grants gives priority to grant requests for Projects/Events that:

- Are Nonprofit (501(c)(3) Organizations
- Support military, veterans, DoD civilians, and their families (Note: the requesting organization's mission does not have to specifically focus on the military, just the project/event for which funds are being requested.)
- The organization must be located within a 50-mile radius of Redstone Arsenal, Alabama
- Meet practical, tangible needs
- Impact multiple people, not just one or a few individuals
- Reflect excellence, innovation, and effectiveness

Limitations: Donations will NOT be provided to/for the following:

- Individuals (only for 501(c)(3) organizations)
- Normal operating expenses (including salaries, overhead, office supplies, or advertising)
- Fundraising Activities
- Completed expenditures
- Goods or services that could be obtained using appropriated funds (no event food or beverage).
- Political parties or activities

Funds donated are to be used for the sole purpose for which they were requested and may not be used to fund other needs not identified in the original request.

Funds must be deposited within 90 days of receipt of check. If any portion of received funding is no longer needed for the requested purpose, unused funds will be returned to RSAMCC.



Honored Legacies for Veterans

Starting off with a customary joke from a World War II veteran is not typically how most meetings begin. But for this organization, it is.

A new senior veteran nonprofit stood up this month and is looking for veterans and volunteers. Honored Legacies for Veterans was created by former Forever Young Senior Veterans in Alabama coordinators Chris Batte and Elaine Oakes. They saw a need in the community to expand beyond Forever Young's primary mission of honoring senior veterans by returning them to the places they fought. The new organization will provide more close-to-home activities and an educational component to their outreach.

Honored Legacies' mission is to honor senior veterans and guard their legacies for future generations. The organization will provide learning tools to local schools through member visits, an "adopt a vet" program and by recording stories of service. Its veterans will serve as primary resources for the students, according to Batte, and give firsthand accounts of the wars in which they served.

"What can they get out of a book better than someone who was there?" Batte said.

Honored Legacies will also sponsor social outings for its members. Excursion and trip costs for veteran members 65 and older will be paid for by the organization.

Batte said they were looking for people with a heart for veterans to join their mission. There is no restriction on membership and no cost to join. "This is what this town does," she said. "We work together to support each other."
