Therefore we have the opportunity to provide additional scholarship funds for 2019. Note that the eligibility requirements are the same as the RSAMCC Merit Awards with one exception. Applicants do NOT need to be a member of the RSAMCC Club to be eligible.

- 1. RSAMCC Merit Award Application For members of RSAMCC and their dependents **Deadline to Apply: Friday, March 1, 2019**
- 2. (New) RSAMCC Military Community Scholarship Application
 The eligibility requirements are the same as the RSAMCC Merit Awards, with
 one exception. Applicants do NOT need to be a member of the RSAMCC Club
 to be eligible. **Deadline to Apply: Friday, March 22, 2019**

NOTE: Applicants eligible for the first scholarship for RSAMCC members (RSAMCC Merit Award Application) who apply prior to the March 1, 2019 deadline will automatically be considered for the second scholarship and do not need to submit two applications. All others and those applying after March 1, 2019 need to use the second application (RSAMCC Military Community Scholarship Application).
